



Blackberry & Cream Biscuits

Ingredients:

- pint fresh blackberries
 cups self rising flour
 tablespoon sugar
 5 cups heavy cream
 unsalted melted butter, to taste
 For the icing (optional):
 1/2 cup confectioners sugar
 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 tablespoon milk



Directions:

Preheat your oven to 500 degrees. In large bowl, combine the self rising flour & sugar. Stir in the heavy cream. Gently fold in the blackberries.

Make drop biscuits or lightly flour a work surface, pat dough into a rectangle on the floured surface, & cut into squares (as detailed in this method here)

Place in a cast iron skillet or a 9×13 casserole dish if you don't own a cast iron.

Bake at 500 for 15-18 minutes. Let cool for a few minutes & then drizzle with the icing if desired.

Slow Cooker Creamy Sun Dried Tomato Chicken

A delicious and creamy chicken recipe that is loaded with amazing flavor! The sun dried tomatoes and basil truly make this meal outstanding!

Ingredients

4 to 6 boneless skinless chicken breasts ¹/₄ cup flour 1 teaspoon salt ¹/₂ teaspoon pepper 4 Tablespoon olive oil 2 cups chicken stock ¹/₂ cup sun dried tomatoes in olive oil 2 Tablespoons basil 1 cup heavy cream

Instructions

Spray slow cooker with cooking spray. Heat large skillet over medium high heat. Add olive oil. Combine flour, salt, and pepper. Dredge chicken in flour mixture and place in skillet. Brown chicken on each side for 2 minutes and place on the bottom of slow cooker. Add chicken stock, sun dried tomatoes and basil. Cook on LOW for about 4 hours or until chicken is cooked through completely. Add heavy cream and serve.





Cool Whip Easter Egg Dye Fun!

SUPPLIES:

Hard-boiled eggs Two 8 oz. tubs of Cool Whip Original Whipped Topping Large glass casserole dish Food coloring (We used McCormick Assorted Food Color and Egg Dye — \$3.67 for set of four, target.com) Distilled white vinegar Bamboo skewers (\$4.95 for 75, amazon.com) Spoon Large bowl


INSTRUCTIONS:

Spoon Cool Whip into casserole dish, and spread evenly with a spatula. Mix food coloring with a few drops of vinegar, then drip mixture randomly over the surface of the Cool Whip. Lightly swirl food coloring into the Cool Whip using a bamboo skewer. Place six hard-boiled eggs into the dish, spaced evenly apart. Coat each egg with the Cool Whip and food coloring mixture, using a spoon to ensure even coverage—one good roll is best! Let eggs sit for about 20 minutes. Remove each egg and rinse in a bowl of cool water. Let dry on a paper towel.



Our In-Home Personal Care Programs provide hands-on services to those whom are medically and financially eligible. Determination of eligibility is based on the completion of a medical assessment. Once guidelines are reviewed and eligibility is determined, the client will be provided with a personal care provider.

Our staff is dedicated to our clients' well-being and to keeping them healthy and in their home for as long as possible. Aides are trained in CPR, and First Aid, and it is mandatory that our caregivers attend classes for continuing health education. In addition, all our aides receive a state-to-state background check and

fingerprinting check.


